Montreal, June 6th 2017 — On June 22nd, La Pépinière — Espaces Collectifs and LA SERRE — arts vivants are inviting the public to re-discover the Village au Pied-du-Courant through a promenade introducing *Entropie*, a design project created by Simon Marcotte and Madly Fuss from Nouveau Studio as part of POSSIBLES, an event of the official programming of Montreal's 375th Anniversary Celebration.

Entropie

The nourishing box of possibles

Composed of exchanges and conversions, energy is a vector of transformation. Constantly impacting what surrounds it, it is an incarnation of a singular potential: to disrupt the unchangeable. How do we reveal this active force? How do we infuse this energy into the architecture that surrounds us today and to Montreal's landscape of tomorrow?

"**Entropie**" is an experimental mobile kitchen project that largely relies on renewable energies. But it is also a dynamic architecture movement through which two universes—the art of culinary transformation and that of land occupation—enter in dialogue. A kinetic exterior envelops this unique kitchen to create an unceasingly moving landscape, revealing the human energy intrinsic to the act of creation.
